Overview of the department



Denis Burkitt Ward is a haematology ward comprising 22 single isolation rooms with a HEPA-air filtering system. The ward provides immediate care to patients from around Ireland who are newly diagnosed with leukaemia and high-grade lymphomas. It is the national referral centre for adult allogenic bone marrow transplants and also provides autologous peripheral stem cell transplants and chimeric antigen receptor T-cell therapy (CAR-T therapy). The ward holds accreditation from the Joint Accreditation Committee ISCT-Europe & EBMT (JACIE) and the Organisation of European Cancer Institutes (OECI). Our team consists of consultant haematologists, clinical nurse managers, senior specialised nurses, clinical support nurses, junior staff nurses, healthcare attendants and support staff.
