## **Breast Care Unit Location and Other Information**

Please expect to be at the clinic for a few hours. Each appointment differs and this may mean some people require more time with the Doctor or Nurse. We also have several different clinics running at the same time. Please do not arrive more than 10 minutes before your appointment time, unless directed to do so.

**Location:** The Breast Care Unit is located on Route 1 on the ground floor of the Main Hospital. From the main concourse reception, take the 1<sup>st</sup> corridor on the right-hand side. The Breast Care unit is located 2<sup>nd</sup> on the right.

**Opening Hours:** The Department of Breast Care is open from the hours of Monday – Friday 8am to 4pm.

**Car Parking:** Parking is extremely limited on site. Long delays can occur accessing parking and hourly charges will apply. Where possible we would advise patients to use public transport.

The car park is particularly busy from 10am to 3pm. Underground car parking is available off Junction 2 to the front of the Main Hospital Entrance. This car park provides internal access, by lift or stairs, to the main Hospital concourse and is accessed by James Street entrance only.

**Bus:** The Bus routes to the hospital are as follows:

123 stops in front of the Main Hospital Entrance

G1, 13, 17, 27, 68, 56A, 77A and 151 have stops located near the campus

**Train:** Heuston Station is located near St James's Hospital. Heuston Station serves routes from Galway, Cork, Limerick, Longford, Sligo, Westport, Portlaoise and Waterford. The hospital can be accessed from Connolly Station via the Red Luas Line. Connolly Station serves routes from Belfast, Rosslare, Wexford and Sligo.
