Overview of the ward



Private 2 Ward is a 30-bedded acute medical and surgical ward. We provide nursing care for patients experiencing a range of acute medical conditions as well as those undergoing both elective and emergency surgeries under various specialties.

We work closely with our multidisciplinary team members; medical social workers, physiotherapists, occupational health, and speech and language therapists, clinical nutritionists and pharmacists to deliver quality, individualised care to each patient.

We are part of the Visual Hospital Initiative which aims to ensure the timely provision of care and improve patient outcomes.



What we do best

Quality and Safety: We are continuously monitoring our practice to ensure the care we deliver is safe and effective. We track this on our designated Quality and Safety Board, where our monthly audits are displayed, including nursing metrics results and patient feedback.

Education: We have a Link Nurse Staff Education Board which is updated monthly covering topics like falls management and pressure ulcers.

Staff Recognition: We aim to create a positive working environment for our nursing and healthcare assistant staff and all of our student nurses. We promote a team approach where every member of staff is valued. With that in mind, we introduced 'Thank You Thursdays', an initiative to recognise and acknowledge the help and support of our colleagues
