

## Overview of the ward



Robert Adams Ward is a 31-bedded ward that specialises in the care of patients with various cardiovascular conditions such as; acute coronary syndrome, chronic cardiac failure, valvular heart disease, and patients requiring cardiac arrhythmia monitoring. Patients admitted to this ward undergo various invasive and non-invasive procedures such as cardiac imaging, coronary angiogram, percutaneous coronary intervention and cardiac device implantation.
